

## Submission Guidelines - Creators of Tomorrow 2026

To be eligible to submit a website to the challenge:

- All participants must be between 15-18 years old\* on submission date (March, 2026)  
\*Ages vary by country - see full [Contest Rules](#) for details
- Where required, participants must ask for parental consent before participating in the challenge.
- You can work in a group of up to 5 participants.
- Your project must be built with [Wix](#), [Wix Studio](#), or [Wix Vibe](#) and use at least one of Wix's business or marketing solutions.
- Your site's language has to be English or have a version in English - you can use [Wix's multilingual feature](#) to add an English version to your pages.
- You must be comfortable communicating in English.
- Sites **do not** need to have a Wix Premium plan. When using the business and marketing solutions, you can add these features to your site and design them as you'd like, but you do not need to upgrade to unlock any Premium features. (For example, you can add Wix Stores to your site, but not set up Payments.)
- Websites can either serve as the impact project itself, or serve as a way to communicate or market an offline impact. For example, you could create a website with a forum that serves as an online community for climate action organizers, or you could create a website that serves as a marketing site for a nonprofit. Either way your website needs to be about a real initiative that currently exists or you plan to create, not just an idea.
- Your website needs to have a mobile version and a desktop version.
- We will consider the following when evaluating your project to be considered for the Semifinals Mentorship Program:

**Project idea:** presented in a compelling, clear, and easy-to-understand manner throughout the website. Addresses a clearly-articulated problem connected to an

SDG. Original, creative, and offers a fresh perspective or approach to addressing the chosen problem.

has continuity and potential for real-world impact.

**Website:** visually engaging, consistent design, use of relevant imagery/media. Intuitive structure and layout. Content interesting, relevant, reasonable and easy to understand. Logically organized and easy to use. All features (links, forms, interactive elements, etc.) function perfectly. Complexity of the website.

### **Judge overall impression**

- In addition to the criteria above, we will consider the following when evaluating the Semifinalists projects and choosing the winners

**Mobile version:** the ux/ui design of the mobile version, its functionality and layout.

**The Final Project pitch:** is it clear, compelling and aligned with the overall goals of the challenge.
